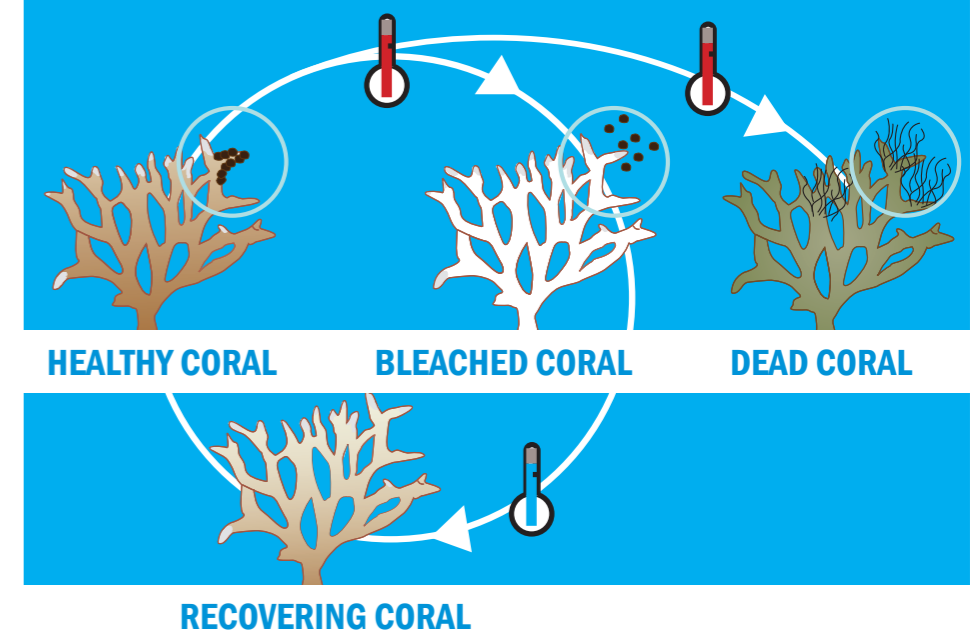

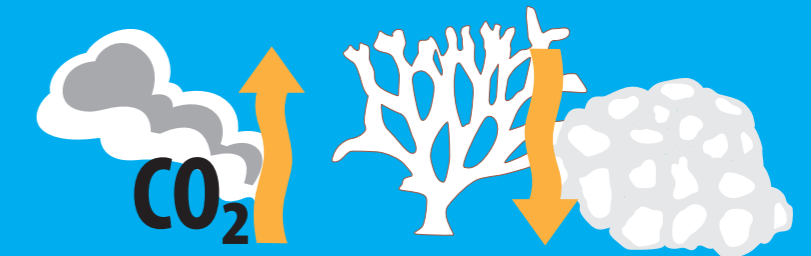


MAIN CAUSES

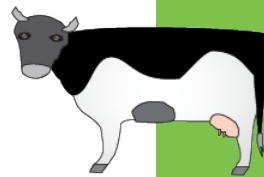
